Surfside Buslines: Minor service delays

Effective Friday October 14, 2011

The Transport Workers Union have notified Surfside Buslines' parent company Transit Australia Group of their intention to take industrial action on Friday.

Surfside Buslines is able to deliver a normal urban and school timetable with the following exceptions:

- Delays may be experienced along high frequency/express routes on the Gold Coast between 7 and 9am.
- The 702 service from the Airport to Paradise Point will not operate until 12.30pm on Friday. A shuttle will be provided to customers from the Gold Coast Airport to connect passengers to high frequency Gold Coast Highway services.

In summary:

- All dedicated Tweed and Gold Coast school services will be delivered as normal
- All urban Tweed services will be delivered as normal
- Some Gold Coast urban services may experience short delays during 7am and 9am. The 702 service will not operate until 12.30pm Friday.
- Services will resume as normal from 12.30pm Friday.



Important message for Parents and Guardians

- If your student/s travel on a dedicated Surfside School Transport bus (which displays a **School Bus** sign on the destination board) you will not be affected by Friday's action.
- If your student/s travel on one or more Surfside urban buses to get to school (these services show a **Route Number** on the destination board) your child may be affected by short delays.
