To become a professional bus driver, you will need:

- Current MR Driver's Licence (minimum) with a clear traffic history record
- QLD/NSW Driving Authority (Surfside employees require both QLD and NSW clearances)
- Current Working with Children Clearance (Surfside Tweed only)
- Australian Work Rights
- Be able to pass a National Criminal History check
- Be able to pass a pre-employment medical and drug & alcohol clearance
- Excellent customer service skills
- Strong commitment to safety
